## About Us

***Bozeman School District #7's Food & Nutrition Services strives to support student achievement, success, and lifelong wellness by providing an innovative school food model that encourages a culture of healthy choices.***

- Our goal is to continuously increase the number of homemade items that are available to students.
- We aim to offer locally sourced food when able.

## School Breakfast

- The high school cafeteria is open from 7:30 until approximately 10:30 for breakfast.
- All breakfast meals include a grain item, fruit, and milk (1% white or skim white), a protein source is frequently offered as well.
- Students are encouraged, but not required to take milk.
- All students must take at least ½ cup of fruit (unlimited available), and the entrée for it to be considered a meal.
- There is a variety of ala carte items available during the morning cafeteria hours as well.

## School Lunch

- A lunch meal includes unlimited fruits & vegetables, an entrée, and milk (1% white, skim white, or skim chocolate). Again, students are encouraged to take milk, but it is not required.
- Students can return and take unlimited fruits and vegetables if they are still hungry, or they may purchase another entrée for \$2.50
- Students bringing lunch from home are able to purchase milk for \$0.50, or access the fruit and vegetable bar for \$0.75.
- There is also a variety of ala carte items available for purchase.

## Meal Accounts

- All students are assigned a meal account when enrolled in the district. If purchasing a school lunch they enter in their student ID number and the cashier charges their account.
- **Ways to Add Money to Account:**
  - Send Money: You can send money with your student, and they can give it to the cashier to add to their account. If you have multiple children in the same school, you can write one check (please designate how much money per child).
  - Add Money Online:
    - Go to [www.bsd7.org](http://www.bsd7.org)
    - From the home page → Our District → Food Services
    - Click on My School Bucks → follow the directions on the screen. (cost \$2.49/transaction)
    - **NOTE:** When using My School Bucks, there is a delay of 1-3 days before the money shows up in the student's account.

## Free & Reduced Lunch

- Applications are available online ([bsd7.org](http://bsd7.org) → Students & Parents → Food Services). **We are unable to accept paper applications for students at BHS** (must be completed online).
- If your student was approved for free/reduced lunch last year, you still need to reapply this year as **last year's status expires 10/7/19**.
- Student's receiving free/reduced meals qualify for a reimbursable meal (breakfast AND lunch), meaning unlimited fruits and vegetables, choice of entrée, and milk. Second entrees and extra milk are not covered by this program.

## Account Balance Notifications:

- Cashiers will notify the student if their account balance is \$5.00 or less.
- Thank you for ensuring your student's meal account stays current.
